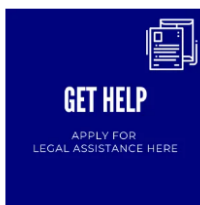
Re: LSLA Response to Coronavirus COVID-19

We wanted to let you know of the Environmental Justice (EJ) Team's response to Coronavirus COVID-19 while our offices in Houston have closed to the public effective March 17, 2020. During this time, our staff is working from home to follow current social distancing protocols.

Here is what this means for you:

- 1. We are still working on your cases; we are just working from home.** Please feel free to reach out to the advocate handling your case as you need information, and we will do our best to provide regular updates to you regarding the status of your case(s). - 2. To keep our communities safe, we are not doing outreaches or community meetings; however, we are still available for conference calls and virtual meetings.** Under the advisement of the CDC, we are not conducting any community meetings at this time. If you have told us you are interested in conducting a meeting in your community, we will advise when we are able to resume these outreaches. We do have the ability to conduct phone calls or conference calls with community groups as needed to address needs.
