



ACP's Affordable Connectivity Program

Federal program to make INTERNET and COMPUTERS available to low income households.

Who Is Eligible for the Affordable Connectivity Program?

1-- the household income is at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines,

2 -- a member of the household meets at least one of the criteria below:

- Participates in one of these assistance programs:
 - Free or Reduced-Price School Lunch Program or School Breakfast Program,
 - SNAP
 - Medicaid
 - Federal Housing Assistance
 - Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
 - WIC
 - Veterans Pension or Survivor Benefits
 - or Lifeline;
- Received a Federal Pell Grant during the current award year;
- Meets eligibility criteria for a participating provider's low-income internet program;
- Lives on Qualifying Tribal lands and participates in assistance programs (BNA Assistance, TANF, Food programs, Head Start).

ACP BENEFITS – What do eligible households get?

INTERNET ACCESS:

Monthly discount of up to \$30-\$75 per month for high speed internet service. VERY LOW COST WITH SOME PROVIDERS. You choose your provider.

A COMPUTER: One-time discount of up to \$100 to purchase a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet from participating providers. Household pays \$10--\$50 toward purchase, depending on the provider chosen.

LONE STAR LEGAL AID helps eligible clients apply for ACP.
