

Disaster Unemployment

1. How do you qualify for Disaster Unemployment Assistance?

- You lost your job due to the disaster.
- You live in or work in a disaster area.
- Your place of employment was damaged or closed.
- You were scheduled to start work, but the job no longer exists.
- You cannot work because of a disaster-incurred injury.

2. How do you apply?

You can apply for Unemployment Disaster Assistance by completing an application at <u>ui.texasworkforce.org</u> OR calling **1-877-872-5627**. You must file this form within 30 days of the announcement of a disaster in your state.

4. What's next?

Once you are done with your application, you MUST send proof of employment, self-employment, or prospective employment within 21 days of applying. During this time, you must show that you are continuing to look for work.

5. Examples of Proof of Employment:

Pay stubs, earnings statements, written statements from your employer, etc.

6. How do you request payments?

You CANNOT request payment online or by calling. You MUST use the paper form that is sent to you. Complete the request form and fax or mail it back.
